What are the requirements to be a student Election Judge?

- Written approval from Parent or Guardian
- Citizen of the United States
- High school student in good standing
- Maintain a grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Certified by passing online Training
- Be able to read, write and speak English
- Be able to work 5AM until all duties are completed after the polls close

ELECTION DEADLINES

Gubernatorial Primary Election Tuesday, June 28, 2022

- School Submission—Forms must be submitted no later than Friday, June 17, 2022
- Training must be completed no later than Monday, June 20, 2022

Gubernatorial General Election Tuesday, November 8, 2022

- School Submission—Forms must be submitted no later than Friday, October 28, 2022
- Training must be completed no later than Monday, October 31, 2022

What a Student Election Judge needs to be.....

- Permitted in writing by parent or guardian
- Citizen of the United States
- High school junior or senior in good standing
- Able to read, write, and speak English
- Maintaining a grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale

What a Student Election Judge needs to do.....

- Skilled in basic addition, subtraction, division and multiplication
- Complete and Submit the Application
- Pass online Training

Compensation

- Student Election Judges will be compensated for working Election Day
- Student Election Judges will be compensated for successfully completing the mandatory training/testing if they work Election Day
- Student Election Judges will receive a check

Election Day

- Gubernatorial Primary Election - Tuesday, June 28, 2022
- Forms should be returned no later than **Friday, June 17, 2022**
- Training must be completed no later than **Monday, June 20, 2022**
